Children attend our programs from all areas of Perth and a wide variety of cultural and religious backgrounds. For those who cannot make it to a Perth-based camp, our 'Eddie on the Road' program delivers our services to regional, rural and remote areas across Western Australia.

It is important work that has a positive ripple effect in the community, with our success measured in the smiles, laughter and new-found confidence of our 'Eddie Rice kids' and the personal growth of our leaders.

In order to provide our not-for-profit camps and programs, we rely on funds raised solely through one-off grants, sponsorship, donations and fundraising. Our fundraising events and initiatives aim to raise vital funds so we can continue to run our programs and potentially increase our reach to even more Western Australian children and families in need.

We are approaching companies and individuals who have a strong community-based focus that resonates with ERCWA's own values and mission. We would be very grateful if you could assist us in helping to raise these funds with either cash donations, items to auction or goods to give away as prizes.
